

Durga Puja Celebration at Sri Sri Maa Kamakhya Devalaya

The **annual fortnight long Durga Puja** rituals are going to be observed in Sri Sri Maa Kamakhya Devalaya from the ninth day of the waning of the moon or '**Krishna Navami**' i.e. **the 14th of September,2017** and it will continue upto the ninth day of the waxing of the moon or '**Sukla Navami**' i.e. **the 29th of September,2017**. It will conclude with Visarjan on the Dashami i.e. the 30th of September,2017.

Due to performance of special rituals during this period, certain changes have been made in the Darshan timing for devotees as mentioned below:

- Temple door will be open for devotees in **9 A.M. till Sunset** from **14th to 20th September,2017**. There will be a break as usual for offering of daily Bhog at **1 P.M.**
- From **21st September to 26th September,2017** the temple door will remain open for devotees from **9 A.M. to 4 P.M.** There will be usual break for offering of daily Bhog at **1 P.M.**
- On the day of **Saptami Puja i.e. 27th September,2017** – temple door will remain open for devotees from **10 A.M. to 4 P.M.** (without any break).
- On the **Maha Astami day i.e. 28th September,2017** – temple door will remain open for devotees from **11 A.M. to 4 P.M.** (without any break)
- On the **Navami day i.e. 29th September,2017** – temple door will remain open for devotees from **11 A.M. to 4 P.M.** (without any break)
- On the **Vijaya Dashami day i.e. 30th September,2017** – the Darshan timing will be from **9 A.M. till Sunset**. There will be a break as usual for offering of daily Bhog at **1 P.M.**
- Due to heavy rush of devotees, **no special pass for defence personnel** will be issued from **21st September to 30th September,2017**.
- Again, Special Entry tickets for Darshan are going **restricted** from during this time.
